# RAJASTHAN JUDICIAL SERVICE EXAMINATION

Judicial services is a prestigious service and if we specifically talk about Rajasthan Judicial services, the Examination is conducted by Rajasthan High Court in three successive stages i.e. Preliminary Examination and Mains Examination followed by an interview

1. Preliminary Examination (Objective Type)
2. Written Main Examination (Subjective Type)
3. Interview

The Preliminary Examination shall be an objective type examination in which 70% weightage will be given to the subjects prescribed in syllabus for Law Papers, and 30% weightage shall be given to test proficiency in Hindi and English language. ### **Personal interview**

In interviewing a candidate the suitability for employment to the service shall be tested with reference to his record at the School. College and [University and his character personality. address and physique. The questions which may be put to him, may be of a general nature and will not necessarily be academic or legal. The candidate will also be put questions to test his general knowledge including knowledge of current affairs and present-day problems. Marks shall also be awarded for the candidate's proficiency in the Rajasthani dialects and his knowledge of social customs of Rajasthan. The marks so awarded shall be added to the marks obtained in the written test by each candidate.

### **Eligibility of Rajasthan Judicial Service Examination:**

- Applicant must be a citizen of India.
- Candidate must have acquired a bachelor degree in law from a recognized institute or university.
- The age of the candidates must be not less than 21 or equal to 35 years.
- The candidates of the SC and ST category will get 3 years relaxation in their upper age.

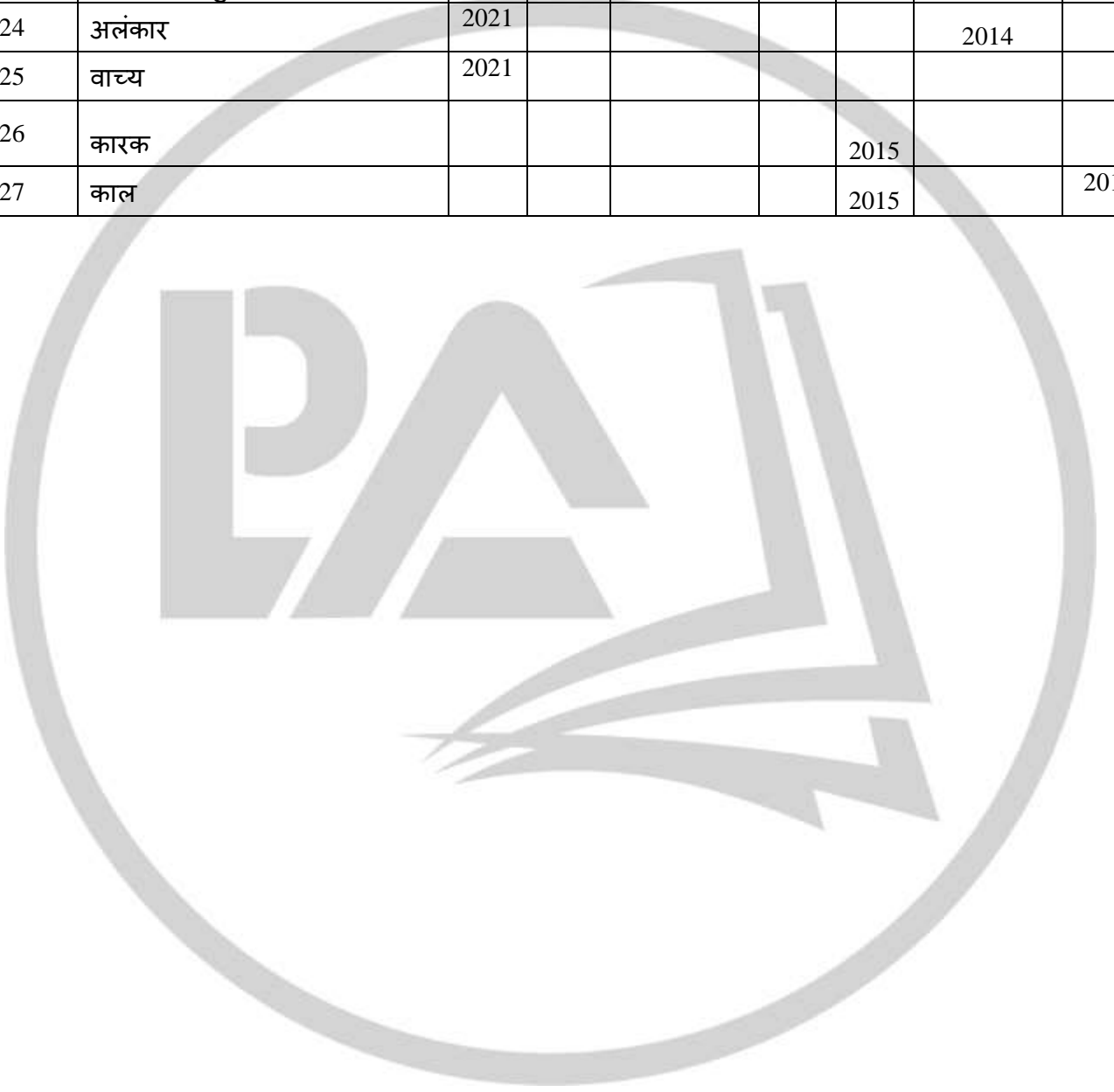
