LAW AND AMENDMENT

Three new Bills in Parliament

- On August 11, 2023, the Central Government introduced three new Bills in Parliament to reform the country's criminal justice system.
- The Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, and Bharatiya Sakshya Adhiniyam legislation were just passed by Parliament. The Indian Penal Code of 1860, the Code of Criminal Procedure of 1898 and the Indian Evidence Act of 1872 would be repealed by these measures.
- > The three Bills were subsequently forwarded to the Parliamentary Standing Committee on Home Affairs for assessment and recommendations.
- Key Highlights of Bharatiya Nyaya (Second) Sanhita Bill, 2023
 - \checkmark It preserves the majority of IPC crimes and adds community service as a form of punishment.
 - ✓ Terrorism is now an offence. It is described as an act intended to endanger the country's unity, integrity, security, or economic security or to instil fear among the population.
 - ✓ Murder by a mob of five or more individuals for a certain identifiable identity, such as caste, language, or personal belief, is punishable by life in jail or death, as well as a fine.
 - ✓ The victim of a sexual assault must now have their statement documented on audio and video.
 - \checkmark For various minor offences, 'community service' has been added as an alternative to incarceration.
 - ✓ Provisions for Zero FIR registration have been created. Within 24 hours, the FIR will be transmitted to the jurisdictional police station.
 - ✓ The maximum prison penalty for "Hit and Run" is ten years.
 - ✓ Kidnapping, extortion, and cybercrime undertaken on behalf of a crime syndicate have been included as offences.
 - \checkmark Sedition is no longer an offence under the law.
- > Key highlights of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha (Second) Sanhita, 2023
 - \checkmark The bill proposes to repeal the Criminal Procedure Code (Cr PC) of 1973.
 - ✓ Forensic examination is now required for offenses with a minimum penalty of seven years in jail.
 - ✓ The inquiry must be completed within 90 days after the filing of the charge sheet. The reserved judgements must be rendered within 30 days.
 - The Medical Examiner will send the victim of sexual harassment's medical examination report to the investigating officer within 7 days.
 - ✓ Fingerprints, voice samples, and specimen signatures or handwriting may be acquired for an investigation or legal proceeding.
- Bharatiya Sakshya (Second) Bill, 2023
 - ✓ It is intended to replace the Indian Evidence Act of 1872 (IEA).
 - ✓ It keeps most of the IEA's provisions, including those on confessions, relevance of facts, and burden of proof.
 - ✓ The IEA recognises two types of evidence: documentary and oral. The distinction is preserved in the measure.
 - ✓ It considers electronic records as documents. Electronic hearings, investigations and trials are possible.
 - ✓ Production of electronic communication devices for a trial, investigation, or inquiry will be authorized since they are likely to include digital evidence.
 - ✓ Confessions made in police custody are similarly inadmissible unless validated by a magistrate.

✓ In cases where an accused has absconded or has failed to answer to an arrest order, the law provides for joint trials for many people.

Anand Marriage Act has come into force in Jammu and Kashmir

- > The Anand Vivah Act relates to marriages within the Sikh community.
- > This Act was passed by the Parliament in the year 2012.
- ▶ At that time it was applicable in all the states/union territories except Jammu and Kashmir.
- > This Act has also come into force in Jammu and Kashmir in December 2023.
- ➢ In the Sikh community it is called 'Anand Karaj'.
- > It means 'working towards happiness' or 'working towards a happy life'.
- It was started by Sikh Guru Amar Das.
- > The purpose of this Act is to legally validate marriages performed in accordance with Sikh traditions.
- Due to Article 370, it was not applicable in Jammu and Kashmir but now after 11 years it has been implemented in Jammu and Kashmir also.

The Supreme Court has accepted the Parliament's decision to abrogate Article 370 as correct.

- > In reference Article 370 petition.
- On December 11, 2023, the Supreme Court delivered its order on the decision taken by Parliament on Article 370.
- > This order was taken by the constitution bench of 5 judges.
- > In the context of Article 370, this decision was given by 5-0.
- > That means all the judges have given a unanimous decision.
- > This decision states that the Parliament's decision to abrogate Article 370 was constitutional.
- Chief Justice of India D.Y. While delivering the judgement, Chandrachud said, Jammu and Kashmir does not have the right to internal sovereignty after its merger with India.
- Article 370 was a temporary provision.
- > On August 5, 2019, Parliament abolished the effect of Article 370 from Jammu and Kashmir.
- Along with this, the state was divided into two parts, Jammu-Kashmir and Ladakh, and both were made union territories.
- Along with this, the Supreme Court decided that elections should be held in Jammu and Kashmir by September 30, 2023.

Nepal – Register Same Sex Marriage

- The Constitution of Nepal, adopted in 2015, took a bold step by explicitly prohibiting discrimination based on sexual orientation.
- > Nepal became the first South Asian country to formally register a case of same-sex marriage.
- This event occurred in the Dordi Rural Municipality of Lamjung district in Western Nepal, where the union of trans-woman Maya Gurung, 35, and gay man Surendra Pandey, 27, was legally recognized.
- In 2007, Nepal's Supreme Court had already set the stage by allowing same-sex marriage, laying the foundation for the recent groundbreaking development.
- Fast forward to June 27, 2023, when the Supreme Court issued an interim order in response to a writ petition, temporarily legalizing same-sex marriage.
- This interim order marked a significant leap toward the official recognition of the rights of the LGBTQ+ community in Nepal.

Modi Govt Plans 7 New Bills For Winter Session

- The upcoming Winter Session of the Parliament is poised to witness significant legislative activity, with the Narendra Modi government planning to introduce seven new Bills alongside addressing 11 pending bills.
- The proposed legislations cover a diverse range of topics, from establishing a Central Tribal University in Telangana to providing women's quota in Jammu and Kashmir and Puducherry Assemblies. Central University (Amendment) Bill, 2023.



- One of the key proposals is The Central University (Amendment) Bill, 2023, aiming to establish a Central Tribal University in Telangana. This move reflects the government's commitment to education and inclusivity.
- Another noteworthy initiative is The Jammu and Kashmir Reorganisation (Amendment) Bill, 2023, which seeks to implement a 33% quota for women in the Jammu and Kashmir Assembly, emphasizing gender representation in the political landscape.
- Addressing the issue of gender representation, The Government of Union Territories (Amendment) Bill, 2023, aims to provide a 33% women's quota in the Puducherry Assembly.
- The government is also set to introduce The Central Goods and Services Tax (Second Amendment) Bill, 2023, aimed at incorporating the recommendations of the GST Council, reflecting the commitment to tax reforms.
- The National Capital Territory of Delhi Laws (Special Provisions) Second Amendment Bill, 2023, seeks to extend the validity of existing laws, offering protection against punitive action for certain forms of unauthorized development in the national capital.
- In an effort to enhance safety regulations, the Boilers Bill, 2023, will revisit a 1923 law related to the safety of life and property. The government emphasizes the need to review and re-enact this legislation for contemporary relevance.
- Similarly, The Provisional Collection of Taxes Bill, 2023, is set to re-enact a 1931 law, indicating the government's commitment to revisiting and updating existing legislation.

Rajya Sabha has passed the bill related to the appointment and tenure of the Chief Election Commissioner and other Election Commissioners

- Recently Rajya Sabha has passed a bill related to the appointment and tenure of the Chief Election Commissioner and other Election Commissioners.
- > This bill was introduced by Union Law and Justice Minister Arjun Ram Meghwal.
- This Bill will replace the Election Commission (Conditions of Service and Tenure of Office of Election Commissioners) Act, 1991.
- It provides for the appointment, salary, and removal of the Chief Election Commissioner and Election Commissioners.
- ➤ As per the provisions of the Bill, the CEC and EC will be appointed by the President on the recommendation of the Selection Committee.
- The selection committee will include the Prime Minister, a Union Cabinet minister and the leader of the opposition in the Lok Sabha or the leader of the largest opposition party.
- According to the Bill, if the Chief Election Commissioner and the Election Commissioner give orders while on duty, the court cannot take action against them.
- According to the Bill, the status of the Chief Election Commissioner and Election Commissioners will be equal to that of a Supreme Court judge.

Parliament gave its nod to raise the age of the president and members of GSTAT.

- ➤ A bill to increase the age limit of the president and member of the GST Appellate Tribunals to 70 years and 67 years, respectively has been approved by the Parliament.
- At present, the age limit for the president is 67 years and for members is 65 years.
- Rajya Sabha returned the Central Goods and Services Tax (Second Amendment) Bill, 2023, to Lok Sabha without any changes.
- ▶ Lok Sabha cleared the Goods and Services Tax (Second Amendment) Bill, 2023.
- The bill also aligned the provisions of the Central GST Act in line with the Tribunal Reforms Act, 2021.
- ➢ Goods and Services Tax Appellate Tribunal (GSTAT):
- ✓ It is a forum of the second appeal in GST laws and the first common forum of dispute resolution between the Centre and States.
- ✓ GST Appellate Tribunal ensures uniformity in the redressal of disputes arising under GST.
- ✓ The National Bench of the Appellate Tribunal is situated in New Delhi.
- ✓ GSTAT is presided by the President and consists of one Technical Member (Centre) and one Technical Member (State).



IMPORTANT DAYS

National Pollution Control Day observed on 2 December

- > National Pollution Control Day is observed every year on 2 December.
- Sustainable Development for a Clean and Healthy Planet" is the theme for this year's National Pollution Control Day.
- It is observed in the memory of those who lost their lives in the 1984 Bhopal Gas tragedy that took place on December 2 and 3.
- Around 45 tonnes of Methyl Isocyanate (MIC) leaked from an insecticide plant in Bhopal killing thousands of people.
- > Every year, people die due to pollution of various kinds.
- > Air pollution and water pollution are degrading the earth's environment very rapidly.

World Computer Literacy Day observed on 02 December

- ▶ World Computer Literacy Day is annually observed on 02 December.
- It was first celebrated in 2001. It was started by NIIT (National Institute of Information Technology), an Indian company, to mark its 20th anniversary.
- > The day emphasizes the importance of computer education. It aims to bridge the digital divide.
- > The day serves as a global initiative to promote computer literacy and digital skills.

Indian Navy Day 2023 celebrated on 4 December

- Navy Day in India is celebrated on 4 December to recognize the achievements and role of the Indian Navy.
- > The iconic Sindhudurg Fort will host this year's Navy Day.
- For the first time, the Indian Navy will organize a mega event away from any major naval station on the occasion of Navy Day.
- Prime Minister Narendra Modi will be the Chief Guest for the event. He will also unveil the grand statue of Chhatrapati Shivaji Maharaj at Rajkot-Malvan.
- ➤ The Indian Navy will showcase its operational skills and capabilities through 'Operational Demonstration' covering a spectrum of naval operations by ships and aircraft at the Sindhudurg Fort on the western seaboard of India on 04 December 2023.
- Indian Navy celebrates Navy Day to commemorate "Operation Trident", which was an attack by the Indian Navy on Karachi harbour during the 1971 War.

World Soil Day 2023 observed on 5 December

- Every year on 5 December, World Soil Day is observed.
- > The main aim of this day is to spread awareness about the importance of maintaining healthy ecosystems.
- ➢ 'Soil and Water, a source of life' is the theme of World Soil Day 2023.
- > The first official World Soil Day was celebrated in 2014.
- ▶ In 2013, the UN General Assembly adopted a resolution designating 5 December as World Soil Day.
- It is observed to bring attention to the importance of healthy soil and to advocate the sustainable management of soil resources.

Dr. Ambedkar's Mahaparinirvan Day is celebrated on 6 December

- Mahaparinirvan Day of Dr. Bhimrao Ambedkar is celebrated every year on 6 December.
- Bhimrao Ambedkar was born on 14 April 1891 in Mhow Military Cantonment, Madhya Pradesh.
- > Dr. Ambedkar died on 6 December 1956 in Delhi.
- > He was posthumously awarded the Bharat Ratna, India's highest civilian award, in 1990.
- > His place of nirvana is known as 'Chaitya Bhoomi'.
- > This 'Chaitya Bhoomi' is situated in Mumbai.
- > Dr. Bhimrao Ambedkar was the first Law and Justice Minister of the country.
- ▶ His 67th Mahaparinirvan day is being celebrated in the year 2023.

- > This day is celebrated every year since December 7, 1949.

- > Charter Day of SAARC is celebrated every year on 8 December.
- > On this day in 1985, the SAARC Charter was adopted in Dhaka during the grouping's first summit.

- SAARC members aim to promote stability, peace and progress in the region.
- SAARC organization includes Bangladesh, Bhutan, India, Maldives, Nepal, Pakistan and Sri Lanka.
- > Afghanistan became the newest member of SAARC in the year 2013.
- > The headquarters and secretariat of this organization is located in Kathmandu, Nepal.

International Anti-Corruption Day is celebrated every year on 9 December

- > International Anti-Corruption Day is celebrated every year on 9 December.
- The theme of this day of the year 2023 will be 'UNCAC. At 20: Uniting the World Against Corruption'.
- The main objective of celebrating this day is to spread awareness against corruption and motivate the civil society including government, private and non-government organizations to take joint action to eradicate corruption.

- The Executive Committee is an important branch of the CAC and member states have a strong interest in obtaining membership of it.

India Re-Elected to the International Maritime Organization Council

- India was re-elected to the Council of the International Maritime Organization (IMO) with the highest number of votes in the elections held on 1 December 2023 in London for the 2024-25 biennium session.
- The 33rd Assembly of the IMO Council is being held from 27 November to 6 December 2023 at the IMO Headquarters in London.
- The Council is an executive body of the IMO and is responsible for monitoring the work of the organization.
- > India comes in the category of ten countries with the greatest interest in international maritime trade.

MHA Declares Canada-Based Lakhbir Singh Landa As A Terrorist Under UAPA

- The Ministry of Home Affairs (MHA) stated that Landa was affiliated with pro-Khalistan elements in Canada.
- The move comes after Canadian Prime Minister Justin Trudeau had accused India of participation in the death of prominent Khalistani terrorist Hardeep Singh Nijjar in Canada.

- Currently, 4% reservation is being given to the disabled in reservation in central government services.

- ▶ A 100-day citizen awareness campaign has been started to create a beggar-free city.
- It appeals to people not to donate to beggars but send them to corporations to work and earn with dignity.
- According to a survey, there are about six thousand beggars in Banaras, out of which 1400 are children.
- Whereas physically able beggars aged between 18 to 40 years living with family or children are also here.
- By giving training to all of them for 3 months, apart from preparing cotton bags and other things, a campaign to start a shop for puja material and flowers will be started in a year.

- Since the establishment of diplomatic relations in June 1948, India and France have enjoyed close and friendly relations for 75 years.
- In 1998, India and France elevated their diplomatic relations to a strategic partnership, which completed 25 years in January 2023.

- More than 1500 individuals performed tabla simultaneously at the 'Taal Darbar' in Gwalior, setting a Guinness World Record.
- Noteworthy officials like Madhya Pradesh Chief Minister Mohan Yadav, Assembly Speaker Narendra Singh Tomar, and Union Minister Jyotiraditya Scindia were present at the event.
- > To commemorate the achievement, Dec 25 will henceforth be celebrated as 'Tabla Divas'.

Madhya Pradesh Cabinet expansion: 28 MLAs took oath

- A total of 28 BJP MLAs, including Prahlad Singh Patel and Kailash Vijayvargiya, are now part of the Madhya Pradesh government's expanded cabinet.
- Six MLAs each from the SC and OBC communities, four from the ST class, and five women ministers were inducted, reflecting diversity and representativeness.
- > This expansion has brought the MP Cabinet strength to 31.

- The objective of this project is to utilize the monsoon surplus water in small rivers like Kalisindh, Parvati, Mej, and Chakan in the East Rajasthan Canal Project.
- Kali Sindh River originates from Dewas district in Vindhyachal Range of Madhya Pradesh, after which it joins Chambal River in Rajasthan.
- Parvati River flows through Sehore and Guna districts, flows through Baran district of Rajasthan, and meets Chambal River near Pali village in Sawai Madhopur district.

57 cybercrime police stations to be opened in Uttar Pradesh

In view of the increasing cases of cybercrime, the cabinet meeting held at Lok Bhawan under the chairmanship of Uttar Pradesh Chief Minister Yogi Adityanath has approved the proposal to set up cybercrime police stations in the 57 districts.



- Cyber police stations are already present in 18 divisional headquarters of the state. A big decision has been made to establish police stations in the remaining 57 districts.
- An estimated amount of more than Rs 1 billion, 27 crore, 24 lakh, 51 thousand will be spent on its establishment.
- Till now, an IG-level officer used to look after these police stations, but after cybercrime stations are established in all the districts, the Superintendent of Police will take over the responsibility.

Home Ministry Declares Muslim League J&K As An Unlawful Association

- The Ministry of Home Affairs (MHA) has declared Muslim League Jammu Kashmir (Masrat Alam faction) as an unlawful association.
- The organisation has been declared unlawful under Section 3(1) of the Anti-Terrorist Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act (UAPA) 1967 for five years.
- According to the Home Ministry, this organisation and its members are involved in anti-national and separatist activities in Jammu and Kashmir.
- They work to support terrorist activities and instigate people to establish Islamic rule in Jammu and Kashmir.
- Unlawful Activities Prevention Act (UAPA), 1967:
 - UAPA is the primary anti-terrorism law enacted in India in 1967.
 - It was enacted to outlaw and punish illegal and terrorist activities which pose a threat to the integrity and sovereignty of India.

'Mazdooron Ka Hit Mazdooron Ko Samarpit' Program Virtually In Indore

- The Prime Minister virtually addressed the 'Mazdooron Ka Hit Mazdooron ko Samarpit' programme, which was planned to pay workers at Indore's Hukumchand Mill who had been owed money for 30 years.
- The Prime Minister urged everyone to take benefit of all government programmes by participating in the Viksit Bharat Sankalp Yatra.
- The Prime Minister cited Asia's largest operational Gobardhan Plant and the city's development of EV charging infrastructure as examples.
- Chief Minister Dr. Mohan Yadav, on behalf of the Prime Minister, symbolically handed over a check of Rs 224 crore to the Official Liquidator and trade union heads of Hukumchand Mill, Indore.
- Under this event, the Prime Minister laid the groundwork for a 60 MW (220 acre) solar power plant being built by Indore Municipal Corporation in the villages of Samraj and Ashukhedi in Khargone district.
- Indore Municipal Corporation issued green bonds of Rs 244 crore to fund the development of the solar facility. It was the country's first urban body to issue green bonds.

Ayodhya Airport to be renamed Maharishi Valmiki Airport

- Ayodhya, the holy city in Uttar Pradesh, is all set to get its first international airport, marking a significant development in its pilgrimage and tourism potential. However, amidst preparations for the grand inauguration on December 30 by Prime Minister Narendra Modi, a potential name change for the airport has emerged.
- The airport currently boasts the lengthy name "Maryada Purushottam Shri Ram International Airport."
- The Yogi Adityanath government is reportedly considering renaming it "Maharishi Valmiki Airport," honoring the revered poet who authored the epic Ramayana.

UP to Build India's First AI City in Lucknow

- In a groundbreaking move, Uttar Pradesh, India's largest state is set to establish the country's first AI city in Lucknow.

- Nirmala Sitharaman, serving as India's first full-time female finance minister, achieves her best ranking yet at number 32, marking her fifth consecutive appearance on the list.

Top 10 Most Polluted Cities Across India

- Northern India has been battling the problem of air pollution for the past few weeks, with several cities experiencing "very poor" air quality.
- The pollution crisis has been particularly severe in Bihar, Rajasthan, and Haryana, with cities such as Begusarai, Bahadurgarh, and Dholpur recording AQI levels above 370.
- The Central Pollution Control Board (CPCB) has released data on the air quality of 242 cities across India.
- According to the data, no city recorded "severe" air quality, but 11 cities, including Delhi, Angul, Faridabad, Bikaner, Bhiwadi, Byrnihat, Arrah, Sonipat, Noida, Dharuhera, and Rohtak, recorded "very poor" air quality.
- The primary cause of air pollution in Northern India is a combination of factors, including vehicular emissions, industrial emissions, and agricultural burning. These factors contribute to the formation of particulate matter (PM), which is a major health hazard.

2023 World Malaria Report

- ➢ In the recently published 2023 World Malaria Report by the World Health Organization (WHO), it was revealed that India accounted for a staggering 66% of malaria cases in the WHO South-East Asia Region in 2022.
- Notably, almost half of all cases in the region (46%) were attributed to Plasmodium vivax, a protozoal parasite and the primary cause of recurring malaria.
- > The report underscores the paradox that, despite efforts to expand access to insecticide-treated nets and preventive medicines for vulnerable populations, the number of malaria cases is on the rise.
- In the WHO South-East Asia Region, which constitutes approximately 2% of global malaria cases, there was a 76% decline in malaria cases from 2000 to 2022.
- ▶ However, the report notes a recent increase in cases, challenging the progress made.

- The NCRB data pointed out that Hyderabad topped the nation in food adulteration cases in 2022. In close second place was Andhra Pradesh, trailing after Telangana.

India Tops Global Remittance Charts with \$125 Billion in 2023: World Bank Report

The World Bank's latest report reveals India's leading position in global remittances, reaching \$125 billion in 2023.



- While remittances to low- and middle-income countries grew by 3.8%, challenges include declines in the Middle East and North Africa. The report underscores the crucial role of inclusive labor markets and social protection policies.
- The World Bank's most recent Migration and Development Brief sheds light on the sustained growth in remittance flows to low- and middle-income countries (LMICs) in 2023, albeit at a slower pace compared to previous years.

- > The PM also launched another climate initiative for industries.
- The 28th Conference of the Parties (COP28) is being held in Dubai from November 30 to December 12.
- Prime Minister Narendra Modi attended the conference on the first two days, and delivered a national statement highlighting India's climate actions.

Target To Make 20 Million Women Associated With SHGs 'Millionaires'

- Lakhpati Didi Scheme: the scheme is in line with the broader mission of poverty alleviation and economic empowerment.
- Under this scheme, skill training will be provided to women so that they can earn more than Rs 1 lakh per year.

Amplifi 2.0 portal has been launched by the Union Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs.

The Union Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs has launched Amplifi 2.0 (Assessment and Monitoring Platform for Liveable, Inclusive and Future-ready urban India) portal.

- This portal will facilitate raw data from Indian cities on a single platform for academics, researchers, and stakeholders to help data-driven policymaking.
- > The data related to total diesel consumption; the number of samples tested for water quality; the average annual expenditure on healthcare; and the total number of people residing in slums will be available on the portal.
- Earlier, data provided by Urban Local Bodies was used by the government to rank cities based on the four indices — the Ease of Living Index, Municipal Performance Index, Climate Smart Cities Assessment Framework, and Data Maturity Assessment Framework.
- ▶ By 2030, about 60 crore (40% of the population) will live in urban areas of India.
- According to the 2011 Census, urban India contribute 63% to the country's GDP.

Health Minister Dr. Mansukh Mandaviya launches "MedTech Mitra" Portal

- Union Health Minister Dr. Mansukh Mandaviya launched MedTech Mitra virtually on 25 December 2023.
- It is a strategic initiative of the Central Government to empower medtech innovators and advance healthcare solutions.
- > MedTech Mitra is a platform for emerging entrepreneurs and innovators in India.
- The portal will be coordinated collaboratively by the Central Drugs Standard Control Organisation (CDSCO) and the Indian Council of Medical Research (ICMR), under the guidance of NITI Aayog's Atal Innovation Mission.
- The MedTech Mitra initiative helps people in the medical technology field work together and make progress in healthcare.

The Geographic Information System application "Gram Manchitra" launched by the Ministry of Panchayati Raj.

- This Geographic Information System has been launched with the aim of promoting spatial planning by Gram Panchayat.
- This application facilitates and assists Gram Panchayats in planning at the Gram Panchayat level using geospatial technology.
- It provides a single/integrated geospatial platform to improve the planning of various developmental works to be undertaken in different areas and provide a decision support system for Gram Panchayat Development Plan (GPDP).
- > In addition, mActionSoft, a mobile-based solution has also been launched.
- It will help in capturing photos with Geo-Tags (i.e. GPS Coordinates) for the works that have assets as an output.

- The INS Imphal is a stealth-guided missile destroyer ship developed for the Indian Navy by Mazagon Dock Shipbuilders Limited (MDL).

- ✓ Putin pledged to complete plans to modernise the Russian navy.

SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY

NASA has launched a mission to study the 'God of Chaos' asteroid

- 'God of Chaos' means 'God of chaos'.
- > This is an asteroid which will pass close to the Earth in the year 2029.
- > Recently, the American space agency NASA has again started a mission to study this asteroid.
- The OSIRIS-REx spacecraft has recently returned from deep space after collecting samples from the space rock 'Bennu'.
- ▶ Its name has been changed to OSIRIS-APEX.
- ▶ It has now been sent to study the asteroid Apophis, which will pass very close to the Earth in 2029.
- > This asteroid will pass near Earth on April 13, 2029, from a distance of about 20,000 miles.

North Korea has successfully tested 'Hasong-18' intercontinental ballistic missile

- > In December 2023, North Korea successfully tested 'Hasong-18' intercontinental ballistic missile.
- > According to North Korea, this missile has been tested to respond to any attack by the United States.
- > The Hasong-18 is a North Korean three-stage solid-fueled intercontinental ballistic missile (ICBM).
- ➢ It is the first solid-fuel ICBM developed by North Korea.
- > The strike range of Hasong-18 is up to 15 thousand kilometers.

The country's first polarimetry mission will be launched by ISRO in January 2024

- The country's first polarimetry mission will be launched by the Indian Space Research Organization (ISRO).
- > This mission will launch on January 1, 2024.
- ▶ In this, X-ray Polarimetry Satellite (XPoSat) will be sent with PSLV-C58.
- > This satellite will collect data of X rays and study black holes and neutron stars.
- > XPoSat will be the third observatory to be established in space after Aditya L1 and Astrosat.
- It is India's first and the world's second polarimetry mission after NASA's Imaging X-ray Polarimetry Explorer, launched in 2021.
- > XPoSat aims to study the 50 brightest sources in the universe.
- These include pulsars, black hole X-ray binaries, active galactic nuclei, neutron stars and the remnants of non-thermal supernovae.

India will launch a female robot astronaut 'Vyommitra' before the Gaganyaan mission

- Recently the Indian Space Research Organization (ISRO) has announced that it will launch a female robotic astronaut 'Vyommitra' before the Gaganyaan mission.
- ▹ 'Vyommitra' will be launched in the year 2024.
- 'Vyommitra' has been developed at Vikram Sarabhai Space Centre.
- It is a female humanoid space robot developed by the Indian Space Research Organization for the manned orbital spacecraft Gaganyaan.
- Vyomamitra is made up of two words Vyoma+Mitra (Vyoma = universe/space, Mitra = friend).
- > This robot has been designed as half humanoid.
- Through this project, ISRO will conduct the first test using this robotic system to ensure the safe travel and return of Indian astronauts, after which it will send the astronauts into space.
- > This humanoid robot was tested on GSLV. MK III.



India has become the first country to have such capability using a single-firing unit

- Recently, Defense Research and Development Organization has shot down 4 targets simultaneously using Akash missile system.
- India has become the first country in the world to do so.
- D.R.D.O. demonstrated the capability of the Akash missile system to simultaneously engage four aerial targets at a range of 25 kilometers.
- India became the first country to demonstrate the capability to engage 4 air targets simultaneously at a distance of 25 km by command guidance using a single firing unit.
- > This ability is Displayed in 'Astra Shakti' military exercises.
- Akash is a short-range surface-to-air missile with a strike range of up to 25 km.
- It is mainly used to protect vulnerable areas and points from air attacks.

China, Egypt Jointly Launch Satellite MisrSat-2

- China and Egypt have achieved a significant breakthrough in their collaborative efforts with the successful launch of the MisrSat-2 satellite.
- Developed and assembled jointly by the two nations, this marks a pivotal moment in their burgeoning space partnership.
- The satellite, assembled in Egypt with Chinese support, was launched from the Jiuquan Satellite Launch Center in northwest China, utilizing the Long March-2C carrier rocket.

JT-60SA is the largest and most advanced nuclear fusion reactor in the world.

- > It started operations in Ibaraki Prefecture of Japan on 01 December.
- ➢ It is a joint initiative between the European Union and Japan. It is the world's biggest experimental nuclear fusion reactor.
- ▶ Fusion differs from fission. Fission is the technique currently used in nuclear power plants.
- Fusion includes fusing two atomic nuclei in place of splitting one nucleus.
- The six-story-tall JT-60SA reactor is kept in a hangar near Naka north of Tokyo. Hangar is a large building where planes are kept.
- It consists of a "tokamak" vessel in the shape of a doughnut that is intended to hold spinning plasma that has been heated to 200 million degrees Celsius.
- JT-60SA is a forerunner for the under-construction International Thermonuclear Experimental Reactor (ITER).

BANKING, ECONOMY AND FINANCE

India will become the world's third-largest economy by 2030.

- > On 5 December, S&P Global Ratings said India will be the world's third-largest economy by 2030.
- But it will be a big challenge for the country to take advantage of the huge opportunity and become the next big global manufacturing hub.
- > The rating agency expects India will be the fastest-growing major economy in the next three years.
- In this, the growth rate of Gross Domestic Product (GDP) will increase from the estimated 6.4% in the current financial year to 7% by the fiscal year 2027.
- The Indian economy grew by 7.2% in the financial year 2022-23 ending March 2023.
- ▶ India's GDP grew by 7.8% in the June quarter and 7.6% in the September quarter.
- Currently, the Indian economy ranks fifth after the US, China, Germany and Japan.
- India has one of the youngest working populations in the world, with approximately 53% of its citizens under the age of 30.
- The rating agency projected that China's GDP growth will slow to 4.6% in 2024 (in 2023: 5.4%), then accelerate to 4.8% in 2025, and return to 4.6% in 2026



The government said the share of agriculture in India's GDP will decline to 15% in fiscal year 2023.

- The government reported on December 19 that the share of agriculture in India's GDP declined from 35% in 1990–91 to 15% last fiscal year due to rapid growth in the industrial and service sectors.
- The share of agriculture in the total gross value added (GVA) of the economy has declined from 35% in 1990-91 to 15% in 2022-23.
- This decline is not due to the decline in agricultural GVA but due to the rapid expansion in industrial and service sector GVA.
- In terms of growth, the agriculture and allied sectors have registered an average annual growth of 4% during the last five years.
- ➤ As far as the global experience is concerned, the share of agriculture in world GDP has also declined over the past decades and has stood at around 4% in recent years.
- > PM-Kisan Yojana was launched in 2019.
- > It is an income support scheme that provides Rs 6,000 per year in three equal installments.
- Under this, over Rs 2.81 lakh crore has been released to over 11 crore farmers till November 30, 2023.

First World Odia Language Conference 2024 to be held in Bhubaneswar


