North Korea passes law to carry out preventive nuclear strike

- North Korea has passed a law allowing itself to carry out a preventive nuclear strike.
- The status of the nation as a nuclear weapons state has become irreversible with the new law.
- The law specifically states that it can use nuclear weapons in case of a nuclear or non-nuclear attack by hostile forces on the state leadership and the command organization of the state's nuclear forces.

Emmy Awards announced-I

- The 74th Emmy Awards took place on 12 Sept 2022in Los Angeles.
- Succession was named the best drama of the year.
- Michael Keaton won the lead actor in a limited series for the show 'Dopesick'.
- "Abbott Elementary" star Sheryl Lee Ralph became the second Black winner to win supporting actress in a comedy series.
- Previously, the award was only won by Jackee Harry for '227'

Emmy Awards announced-II

- ➤ Ted Lasso won Outstanding Comedy Series.
- Lee Jung-jae won Lead Actor in Drama for Squid Game.
- ➤ He has become the first Asian star to win the Emmy award.
- > Zendaya won Lead Actress, Drama for Euphoria.
- ➤ Jean Smart of 'Hacks' won best actress in a comedy series.
- ➤ The White Lotus won Best Limited or Anthology Series.

6th Japan India Maritime Exercise begins in Bay of Bengal

- ➤ The 6th edition of Japan India Maritime Exercise 2022 (JIMEX 22) hosted by the Indian Navy began in the Bay of Bengal on 11 Sept'22.
- The Indian Navy is represented by 3indigenously designed and built warships; Sahyadri, a multipurpose stealth frigate, and Anti-Submarine Warfare Corvettes Kadmatt and Kavaratti.

Darjeeling zoo adjudged the best zoo in India

- The Padmaja Naidu Himalayan Zoological Park of Darjeeling has been recognised as the best zoo in the country.
- Arignar Anna Zoological Park in Chennai came second, followed by the Sri Chamarajendra Zoological Gardens in Mysore, Karnataka
- The ranking list was released by the Central Zoo Authority (CZA) in Sept 2022.
- The Darjeeling zoo was established on August 14, 1958

Liz Truss elected as UK's new Prime Minister

• UK Foreign Minister Liz Truss was elected as the next Prime Minister of Britain & leader of the governing Conservative Party on 5 September 2022.



- With the win, she has become the third female Prime Minister of the United Kingdom after Theresa May and Margaret Thatcher.
- Liz defeated her rival & former Finance Minister Rishi Sunak by a margin of 20927 votes, after a six-week-long campaign.

India and Germany hold consultations on UN and other issues

- India and Germany held consultations on United Nations and other multilateral issues on 2 September 2022.
- Joint Secretary (UN-Political) in Ministry of External Affairs Prakash Gupta led the Indian delegation.
- Both sides also briefed each other on their respective priorities for the upcoming 77th Session of the UN General Assembly.

India overtakes UK to become world's fifth biggest economy

- India leaped past the UK in the final three months of 2021 to become the fifth-biggest economy, according to a report by Bloomberg.
- The ranking is based on GDP figures compiled by the International Monetary Fund (IMF).
- India is behind just the US, China, Japan and Germany.
- India's economy is projected to grow at 7% in 2022-23.
- India registered a growth of 8.7 per cent in 2021-22.

Iga Swiatek wins 2022 US Open women's singles title

- O World number one tennis player Iga Swiatek won the US Open women's singles title on 10 September 2022.
- o She defeated Tunisia's On Jabeur in the final
- o It was Iga Swiatek's third Grand Slam win of her career.
- o Poland's Swiatek also won the French Open in 2020 and 2022besides winning the US Open in 2022.
- o The US Open Tennis Championships is held annually in Queens, New York.
- o First held: 1881

US announces hosting first-ever US-Pacific Island Country Summit

- o The US has announced hosting the first-ever US-Pacific Island Country Summit.
- o It will be held in Washington from 28th to 29th September 2022.
- o US President Joe Biden will host the Summit.
- The Summit will demonstrate the United States' partnership with Pacific Island countries and the Pacific region.

Army Chief reaches Kathmandu on four-day visit to Nepal

- o Indian Army Chief General Manoj Pande is on a 4-day visit to Nepal from 5-8 September 2022.
- o This is his first visit to Nepal as Chief of Army Staff.
- O During his visit, he will call on the President and Prime Minister of Nepal.
- O He will be conferred with the honorary rank of General of Nepal Army on 6 Septemer 2022 in a ceremony at Sital Nivas, the official residence of President of Nepal.

Winners of Ramon Magsaysay Awards 2022 announced

- ✓ The Ramon Magsaysay Award Foundation has announced the winners of the 64th Ramon Magsaysay Award 2022.
- ✓ The awardees are: Sotheara Chhim (Cambodia), Bernadette Madrid (Philippines), Tadashi Hattori (Japan) & Gary Bencheghib (Indonesia).
- ✓ The award is named after Ramon Magsaysay, the 7th president of the Republic of the Philippines.
- ✓ It is regarded as "Asia's Nobel Prize".
- ✓ First awarded: 1958



Indian GM Aravindh Chithambaram wins Dubai Open chess tournament

- ✓ Indian Grandmaster Aravindh Chithambaram on 4 September 2022 won the 22nd Dubai Open chess tournament with 7.5 points from nine rounds.
- ✓ Chithambaram defeated R Praggnanandhaa in the ninth and final round.
- ✓ Seven Indians finished in the top 10 at the tournament with R Praggnanandhaa sharing the second spot with five others.

Subroto Cup International Football Tournament kicks off in New Delhi

- ✓ The Subroto Cup International Football Tournament kicked off on 6 September 2022.
- ✓ The 61st edition of the tournament will be staged across four venues in Delhi till 13 October 2022.
- ✓ The first match was played between NCC versus Chandigarh.
- ✓ The Subroto Cup is an annual school's football tournament inaugurated in 1960 by the first Indian Air Force chief, Air Marshal Subroto Mukerjee.

New Zealand's Colin de Grandhomme retires from international cricket

- ♣ New Zealand all-rounder Colin de Grandhomme announced his retirement from international cricket on 31 August 2022.
- **↓** Colin represented New Zealand in 29 Tests, 45 ODIs, and 41 T20Is.
- 4 He was a part of the New Zealand team that won the inaugural ICC World Test Championship.
- 4 He scored 1,432, 742, and 505 runs in Test, ODI, and T20I cricket, respectively.

Anishka Biyani wins Gold medal in Malaysian chess meet

- ♣ Six-year-old Anishka Biyani won the gold medal in the Malaysian Age Group Rapid Chess Championship at Kuala Lumpur on 4 September 2022.
- ♣ Anishka, a first-grade student of Dhirubhai Ambani school, achieved the feat in the Under-6 Open category.
- In July 2022, Anishka also qualified as one of the best under-7 players in the All India FIDE rating chess tournament held in Hyderabad.

UNESCO expert visits Hoysala temple in Halebeedu

- → Tiong Kian Boom, an expert from International Commission on Monuments and Sites (ICOMOS), visited Hoysaleshwara temple in Halebeedu, Karnataka on September 14, 2022.
- ♣ The Hoysala structure is an aspirant for the tag of World Heritage Site, which is given by UNESCO.
- ♣ It is a 12th-century Hindu temple dedicated to Lord Shiva

India & UAE sign MoU to establish Cultural Council Forum

- India and UAE signed an MoU to establish the Cultural Council Forum to deepen the partnership between the two countries.
- ♣ It was signed during the 14th India-UAE Joint Commission Meeting in Abu Dhabi on 1 September 2022.
- The meeting was co-chaired by EAM S Jaishankar and his UAE counterpart Sheikh Abdulla bin Zayed Al Nahyan.

- ♣ President: Mohamed bin Zayed Al Nahyan

International Day of Charity: 5 September

- Every year on 5 September, people around the world observe the International Day of Charity to mark the death anniversary of Mother Teresa.
- ❖ She was awarded the Nobel Peace Prize in 1979 for her efforts in the fight against poverty and suffering.
- ❖ This day was first marked by the UN General Assembly in 2012.
- This day encourages all NGOs and volunteer groups to carry out charitable endeavours.



India to host Quad senior officials' meeting

- ❖ India will host an official-level meeting of the Quad grouping on September 5-6, 2022 in New Delhi.
- ❖ It will be the first such "Senior Officers Meeting" to be held since tensions with China over Taiwan have risen.
- ❖ The meeting will review progress of initiatives that were discussed during the Quad summit in Tokyo in May 2022.
- Quad Members: India, Australia, Japan & the US

Volker Turk appointed as next UN High Commissioner for Human Rights

- Volker Turk of Austria has been appointed as the next United Nations High Commissioner for Human Rights.
- ❖ He is currently coordinating global policy work as an Under-Secretary-General in the UN's Executive Office.
- ❖ Previously, he was the Assistant High Commissioner for Protection at UN refugees, UNHCR, in Geneva.
- ❖ Turk will succeed Michelle Bachelet of Chile

Suella Braverman inducted as Home Secretary in UK Cabinet

- **↓** Indian-origin barrister Suella Braverman is the new Home Secretary of United Kingdom.
- ♣ She has been appointed new Home Secretary by Prime Minister Liz Truss.
- ♣ She has succeeded her colleague of Indian origin Priti Patel.
- She had served as the Attorney General in the earlier government led by Boris Johnson.

First Homoeopathy International Health Summit held in Dubai

- The first edition of the "World Health Summit for Pride of Homoeopathy" was held in Dubai on 29 August 2022.
- ♣ Aim: to promote a homoeopathic system of medicine, drugs, and practices.
- ♣ Theme of summit: "Diseases caused by climate change and global warming".
- It was organised by Burnett Homoeopathy Pvt Ltd & was addressed by Ashwini Kumar Choubey, MoS, Environment Forest & Climate change.

Sanjay Verma appointed next high commissioner to Canada

- Senior diplomat Sanjay Kumar Verma has been appointed as India's next high commissioner to Canada.
- He is a 1988 batch officer of the Indian Foreign Service and is currently the ambassador of India to Japan.
- He has also served as Consul General of India in Milan, Italy.
- Amit Kumar, currently Consulate General of India in Chicago, has been named the next ambassador to the Republic of Korea.

All India Football Federation

- The All India Football Federation is the governing body of football in India under jurisdiction of Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports.
- Formed in 1935 at Darbhanga, the federation was one of the founding members of the Asian Football Confederation.
- It is headquartered in New Delhi.
- It is also part of the South Asian Football Federation, the organization that runs football in South Asia.

Kargil International Marathon inaugurated

- In Ladakh, Chief of Army Staff General Manoj Pandey inaugurated the Kargil International Marathon in September 2022.
- It was inaugurated with by flagging off a 42 Km Full Marathon.



• Over 2000 runner stook part in the Full (10 Km) and Half (5 Km) run in the marathon organized by Ladakh Autonomous Hill Development Council Kargil, Ladakh Police in collaboration with Sarhad Pune

India beat Nepal 4-0 to clinch SAFF U-17 Championship title in Colombo

- In football, India clinched the SAFF under-17 Championship title, defeating Nepal 4-0 in the final in Colombo on September 14, 2022.
- India captain Vanlalpeka Guite was named the Most Valuable Player of the Tournament, while goalkeeper Sahil won the Best Goalkeeper awards.
- India also won previous season title by beatingNepal7-0 on 31 August 2019

Rachael Haynes announces retirement from international cricket

- ❖ Australian woman cricketer Rachael Haynes has announced her retirement from international cricket.
- ❖ She is also retiring from state cricket.
- ❖ She would, however, play one more season for Sydney Thunder in the Women's Big Bash League.
- ❖ She has scored 3,818 runs in more than 150 internationals over all three formats since her debut in 2009 and won six global titles with Australia.

Kalyan Chaubey appointed as President of AIFF

- ❖ The All India Football Federation (AIFF) has got a former player as its first president in its 85-year history with Kalyan Chaubey beating Bhaichung Bhutia in the election.
- ❖ Chaubey is a former goalkeeper with Mohun Bagan and East Bengal.
- * Karnataka Football Association president N A Haris, won the election for the post of vice president, beating Manyendra Singh of Rajasthan FA.

Max Verstappen wins 2022 Dutch F1 Grand Prix

- * Red Bull's Max Verstappen won the Dutch Formula 1 Grand Prix on 4 September 2022.
- ❖ Mercedes' George Russell & Ferrari's Charles Leclerc came at the 2nd and 3rd positions respectively.
- Verstappen has now won 10 of this season's 15 races.
- ❖ It was his 72nd podium finish & he collected 26 points from this race.
- Verstappen won the Dutch GP in 2021 as well. He has now won a total of 30 races.

Barack Obama wins Emmy award for his narration in Netflix documentary

- Former US President Barack Obama has won the Emmy Award for his narration in the Netflix documentary "Our Great National Parks", which features national parks from across the globe.
- Obama is the 2nd US president after Dwight Eisenhower, to win an Emmy award.
- Earlier, Obama has also received Grammy Awards for the audiobook readings of his memoirs "The Audacity of Hope" & "A Promised Land."

Smart Solutions Challenge & Inclusive Cities Awards 2022 presented

- The Minister for Housing and Urban Affairs Hardeep Singh Puri presented Smart Solutions Challenge & Inclusive Cities Awards 2022 on 1 September 2022.
- These awards are an initiative of the National Institute of Urban Affairs (NIUA) and UN to address city-level accessibility and inclusion challenges faced by persons with disabilities (PwD), women and girls, and the elderly.

Bangladesh Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina to pay four-day visit to India

- Bangladesh Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina will be on a four-day visit to India from 5 September 2022.
- She will hold bilateral consultations with Prime Minister Narendra Modi.
- She had, earlier, visited India in October, 2019.
- While, from India's side, former Indian President Ram Nath Kovind and PM Narendra Modi had visited Bangladesh between March and December 2021.



PM commissions India's first indigenous aircraft carrier INS Vikrant

- PM Modi commissioned the first indigenous aircraft carrier INS Vikrant on 2 September 2022 at Cochin Shipyard Limited in Kochi.
- He also unveiled the new Naval Ensign (Nishaan).
- Naval Ensigns are flags that naval ships or formations bear to denote nationality.
- The current Indian Naval Ensign consists of a St. George's Cross -- a red cross with white background.

Apeksha Fernandes: 1st Indian woman to reach WJS C'ships final

- Apeksha Fernandes became the first Indian woman to reach the final of the World Junior Swimming Championships on 31 August 2022.
- Fernandes clocked her 'Best Indian Time' of 2:18.18 to qualify for the final.
- She finished 8th in the 200m women's category event.
- The 8th World Junior Swimming Championships is taking place from 30 August to 4 September 2022 in Lima, Peru

Carnatic vocalist T.V. Sankaranarayanan passes away

- Renowned Carnatic vocalist & the Padma Bhushan awardee T.V. Sankaranarayanan passed away at the age of 77 in September 2022.
- He won the Sangita Kalanidhi award of the Music Academy in 2003.
- In 2003, the Central Govt also conferred on him Padma Bhushan.
- He was considered the torch-bearer of the Madurai Mani Iyer style of singing and technique.

Bangladesh player Mushfiqur Rahim announces his retirement from T20Is

- ➤ Bangladesh wicketkeeper-batter and former captain, Mushfiqur Rahim on 4 September 2022 announced his retirement from T20 internationals.
- ➤ He represented Bangladesh in 102 T20Is, scoring 1,500 runs at an average of 19.48.
- ➤ He made his T20I debut in 2006 against Zimbabwe.
- ➤ He has now become the second player from Bangladesh to retire from T20Is following Tamim Iqbal's retirement in July 2022.

India co-sponsors a UN resolution tabled by Argentina

- ➤ India has co-sponsored United Nations General Assembly resolution that proclaimed September 16 as International Day for Interventional Cardiology.
- ➤ The resolution was tabled by Argentina.
- ➤ The day will raise awareness about that field of medicine which improves public health and increases life expectancy.

Piyush Goyal to visit San Francisco and Los Angeles from 5-10 Sept

- ➤ The Union Minister of Commerce and Industry, Consumer Affairs, Food and Public Distribution and Textiles, Piyush Goyal will visit San Francisco and Los Angeles from 5- 10 September 2022.
- ➤ He will attend the India-US Strategic Partnership Forum conference and IndoPacific Economic Framework (IPEF) Ministerial meeting.
- ➤ IPEF was launched by USA on May 23, 2022 at Tokyo.

CCS clears indigenous LCA Mark 2 fighter aircraft project

- The Cabinet Committee on Security have cleared the development of LCA Mark 2 fighter aircraft.
- It would be a replacement for the Mirage 2000, Jaguar and MiG-29 combat aircraft in the Indian Air Force.
- The DRDO would be developing the aircraft with a GE-414 engine which is the advanced version of the GE-404s.
- GE-404s power the existing LCAs and the 83 LCA Mark 1As.



Cabinet approves MoU between India and UAE

- ♣ The Union Cabinet has approved to sign of an MoU between the Ministry of Education, India, and the Ministry of Education of the Government of UAEon cooperation in the field of education.
- The MoU will be valid for a period of five years from the date of signing and will be automatically renewable with the consent of both parties.
- **↓** It shall supersede the earlier MoU signed with UAE in 2015.

Cabinet approves MoU between India and United Kingdom

- ♣ The Union Cabinet has approved an MoUbetween India and the Government of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland on mutual recognition of academic qualifications.
- ♣ It was signed on 25 April 2022.
- Lt will promote bilateral exchange of information about educational structure, programs and standards and increase mobility of students and professionals between the two countries.

Cabinet approves MoU between India and Maldives

- The Union Cabinet has approved the MoU between the National Disaster Management Authority, India and the National Disaster Management Authority of the Republic of Maldives on cooperation in the field of disaster management.
- ♣ It seeks to put in place a system, whereby both will be benefited from the disaster management mechanisms of each other.
- ♣ NDMA headquarters: New Delhi
- Lestablished: 2005

US issues highest number of student visas to Indians in 2022

- The United States has issued a record of 82,000 student visas to Indians in 2022.
- ♣ Indian students received more US student visas than any other country.
- As per the embassy, Indian students comprise nearly 20 percent of all international students studying in the United States, with the Open Doors report in 2021 showing there were 167,582 students from India in the 2020-2021 academic year.

5th India-US Maritime Security Dialogue held on 8 September 2022

- ♣ The 5th India-US Maritime Security Dialogue was held in New Delhi on 8 September 2022.
- Both sides discussed developments in the global maritime domain, bilateral maritime cooperation endeavors, regional support initiatives and collaborative efforts.
- ♣ They agreed to remain engaged with the objective of further enhancing the India-US Comprehensive Global Strategic Partnership.

Three Indian cities join UNESCO Global Network of Learning Cities

- ♣ Telangana's Warangal along with Kerala's Nilambur and Thrissur has joined the UNESCO Global Network of Learning Cities (GNLC).
- These cities have been recognized for their outstanding efforts to make lifelong learning a reality for all at the local level.
- ♣ The UNESCO GNLC is an international network consisting of 294 cities that successfully promote lifelong learning across their communities.

India-Japan '2+2 Ministerial Dialogue' to be held in Tokyo on Sept 8

- ♣ Defence Minister Rajnath Singh along with EAM Dr S Jaishankar will participate in the 2nd India-Japan '2+2 Ministerial Dialogue' in Tokyo on 8 September 2022.
- The Japanese side will be represented by Yasukazu Hamada and Yoshimasa Hayashi.
- **This Dialogue will review the bilateral cooperation across domains.**
- ♣ The year 2022 also marks 70 years of diplomatic relations between the two countries.

Britain's Queen Elizabeth II passes away at 96

Queen Elizabeth II, Britain's longest-serving monarch, passed away at the age of 96 on 8 September 2022.



- ♣ She came to the throne at the age of 25 in 1952 after the sudden demise of her father King George VI
- ♣ Queen Elizabeth ruled over Britain for 70 years.
- ♣ Her eldest son, Prince Charles, 73, will be the new king of the UK, according to centuries of protocol.

India ranks 132 in UNDP's Human Development Index 2021

- ♣ India ranked 132 out of 191 countries in the 2021 human development index (HDI), according to a report released by the United Nations Development Programme (UNDP).
- 4 Among India's neighbours, Sri Lanka (73rd), China (79th), Bangladesh (129th) and Bhutan (127th) are ranked above India.
- ♣ Switzerland remained at the top spot, followed by Norway and Iceland.
- ♣ India ranked 131in the 2020index

Carlos Alcaraz beats Casper Ruud to win US Open title

- ✓ Carlos Alcarazon 11 Sept 2022beat Norway's Casper Ruud 6-4 2-6 7-6(1) 6-3 in the US Open final to claim his first Grand Slam title and rise to the top of the world rankings.
- ✓ With the win, Alcaraz became the youngest Grand Slam champion since his compatriot Rafael Nadal at the 2005 French Open champion and the youngest winner of the US Open title since Pete Sampras in 1990.

A three-day international conference ANGAN 2022 held

- ✓ A three-day international conference ANGAN 2022 (Augmenting Nature by Green Affordable Newhabitat), titled "Making the Zero-Carbon Transition in Buildings" began on 14th Sept 2022.
- ✓ ANGAN 2.0 is being organised by the Bureau of Energy Efficiency (BEE)in collaboration with Swiss Agency for Development & Cooperation (SDC)
- ✓ It was held under the Indo-Swiss Building Energy Efficiency Project

Gautam Adani overtakes Jeff Bezos to become world's second richest

- ✓ Adani Group's Chairperson Gautam Adani has surpassed Amazon's Jeff Bezos to become the world's second richest person.
- ✓ He is now only behind Tesla CEO Elon Musk, who remains the world's richest man with a net worth of \$273.5 billion.
- ✓ According to the Forbesreal-time billionaires list, Adani's net worth stood at \$155.7 billion as of September 16, 2022, up by \$5.5 billion or nearly 4%.

UNICEF appoints climate activist Vanessa Nakate as Goodwill Ambassador

- ✓ 25-year-old Ugandan climate activist Vanessa Nakate has been appointed as the newest UNICEF Goodwill Ambassador.
- ✓ She has been recognized by UNICEF for her outstanding global advocacy for climate justice for current and future generations.
- ✓ Most recently, UNICEF appointed actress Millie Bobby Brown as its youngest-ever Goodwill Ambassador.
- ✓ UNICEF HO: New York
- ✓ President: Catherine M. Russel

10th IBSA Trilateral Ministerial Commission meeting held in New York

- ✓ It was held on 21 September 2022.
- ✓ It was chaired by External Affairs Minister Dr. S. Jaishankar.
- ✓ Minister of Foreign Affairs of Brazil Carlos Alberto Franço França and Minister of Health of South Africa Dr. Joe Phaahla were also present during the meeting.
- ✓ The Ministers reviewed the entire gamut of IBSA cooperation.
- ✓ IBSA-India-Brazil-South Africa
- ✓ IBSA Dialogue Forum was founded in 2003



India wins UN award for hypertension control initiative

- India on 21 Sept 2022won a United Nations award for its 'India Hypertension Control Initiative (IHCI)'.
- The IHCI has been recognized for its exceptional work within India's existing primary healthcare system.
- Under this initiative, more than 34 lakh people with hypertension are taking treatment in Govt. health facilities.
- IHCI launched:2017

Valery Polyakov, took longest single trip to space, passes away

- Valery Polyakov, the Soviet cosmonaut who set the record for the longest single stay in space, passed away at the age of 80 on 19Sept 2022.
- Polyakov's record of 437 days in space began on January 8, 1994, when he and two others blasted off on a two-day flight to the Soviet space station Mir.
- Polyakov previously had spent 288 days in space on a mission in 1988-89

International Literacy Day: 8 September

- International Literacy Day is observed on the 8th of September every year.
- It is observed to make people aware of the meaning and importance of literacy for individuals and societies.
- Literacy refers to a person's ability to read or write.
- UNESCO established this Day in 1966 & it was first celebrated on September 1967.
- 2022 Theme: "Transforming Literacy Learning Spaces"

International Red Panda Day: 17 September

- International Red Panda Day is celebrated every year on the third Saturday of September.
- In 2022, this day falls on 17 Sept.
- This day is commemorated to raise awareness about the red panda conservation issues.

- India is home to the largest number of Greater One-Horned Rhinoceros in the world

• Considered India's senior-most archaeologist, Lal was actively involved in archaeological research and writing till the age of 100.

Vande Bharat 2: Railways to introduce new avatar of high-speed train

- Indian Railways will be introducing the new avatar of high-speed train Vande Bharat called Vande Bharat 2.
- It will be equipped with more advancements and improved features like 0 to 100 Kmpl speed in just 52 seconds, maximum speed up to 180 Kmph, and lesser weight of 392 tons instead of 430 tons.
- In the new design, photo-catalytic ultraviolet air purification system has also been installed.

Sikkim to host Ranji Trophy matches for the first time

- Sikkim will host Ranji trophy matches for the first time in December 2022.

- Justice KN Singh was appointed as the 22nd CJI on 25 November 1991 & he retired on 12 December 1991.
- Justice Y V Chandrachud (16th CJI) had the longest tenure (7 Years, 4 Months & 20 days) as CJI till today

- He passed away in 1982.

National Forest Martyrs Day: 11 September

- September 11 is marked as National Forest Martyrs Day in India every year.
- The day is observed to pay tribute to the numerous activists who have laid down their lives to protect forests and wildlife across India.
- The Ministry of Environment chose September11 as the day to mark National Forest Martyrs Day in 2013 as it was the anniversary of the Khejarli Massacre (1730).

- For the first time a legal statute is being given in the state, making Kannada mandatory, aimed at protecting the language and its users.

Madhya Pradesh schools to go 'bagless' once a week
