SELECTIONPROCESS:

The Jammu and Kashmir Judicial Services Competitive Exam is conducted by the Bihar Public Service Commission involving three stages of the selection process viz., Preliminary (Objective) Exam, Mains (Written).

- Mode of exam: Offline
- Official Website: bpsc.bih.nic.in

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA:

- A candidate needs to be a citizen of India.
- A candidate needs to have the domicile of Jammu and Kashmir to get the reservation benefits.
- Applicants must have completed LLB from any recognized institute.
- The age of the applicants must be between 22 years and 35 years.
- The upper age limit for women and physically disabled persons is extended to 40 years.

MAINS EXAMINATION

The Exam consists of two papers:
