SELECTIONPROCESS:

The acceptance of Karnataka **District Judge Application forms** will be based on the dates specified in the notification. If a candidate does not meet the required eligibility, their application form will be rejected. Those who have applied need to attend the Preliminary exam, Mains Exam, and Interview. The **Karnataka High Court** conducts the Karnataka Judicial Service Examination annually to hire candidates for the Civil Judge cadre, and this year, there are **57 vacancies for direct recruitment as civil judges.**

- A candidate needs to be a citizen of India.
- A candidate needs to have the domicile of **Karnataka** to get the reservation benefits.

- The age of the applicants must be between 22 years and 35 years.
- The upper age limit for women and physically disabled persons is extended to 40 years.
