### Selection Process

The selection process for HPSC HCS Judicial Branch Recruitment 2024 consists of the following stages:

**Stage-1: Prelims Written Exam** Candidates are required to participate in a preliminary written examination to shortlist individuals for the next stage.

**Stage-2: Mains Written Exam** Successful candidates from the preliminary exam proceed to the main written examination, which assesses in-depth knowledge of the subjects.

**Stage-3: Interview** Candidates qualifying in the main examination may be called for an interview, where their personality, communication skills, and suitability for the role are evaluated. The interview is conducted for a total of 100 marks.

**Stage-4: Document Verification** Shortlisted candidates may undergo document verification to confirm their eligibility and credentials.

**Stage-5: Medical Examination** Selected candidates may be subjected to a medical examination to ensure they meet the required health standards.
