- The Exam will be Objective Type.
- ✤ The time Duration for the Examination will be 2 Hours.
- The Exam shall be of 100 marks in aggregate.
- There shall be negative marking of -1 mark (minus one) for each wrong answer.

VIVA-VOCE(INTERVIEW)

- Personal interview test will carry 100 marks.
- Jharkhand Civil Services (Judicial) Eligibility Criteria:-
- An applicant must be a citizen of India.
- He must have completed the bachelor level law degree from a recognized institute.
- The age of the applicants must not exceed 22 years.
- The maximum age of the candidates must not be more than 35 years.
- The candidates of the reserved category will be given the appropriate relaxation in their upper age.
- The relaxation in the upper age for the candidates of the SC and ST category will be 5 years.
- Candidates of the OBC category will be offered the age relaxation of 3 years.
