- ❖ The Exam will be Objective Type.
- ❖ The Exam will be of 100 Marks/ Questions.
- ❖ The time Duration for the Examination will be 02 Hours.
- ❖ There will be no Negative Marking.

The Preliminary Examination shall be an objective type examination in which 70% weightage will be given to the subjects prescribed in syllabus for Law Papers, and 30% weightage shall be given to test proficiency in Hindi and English language. The marks obtained in the preliminary examination shall not be counted towards the final selection.
